Dear Sirs:

Greetings to each of you. I pray you and families are well and staying safe.

I want to thank you for your commitment to seeking fairness and justice for the individuals of the Church of God in Christ who have been abused, defrauded and wrongfully dealt with in many instances. Who would have ever thought this was a saved, sanctified, Holy Ghost filled denomination? I pray for those who have suffered as a result of the injustices that have been perpetrated by the hands of the Leadership of this church. I pray they do not get discouraged, give in, leave the church or worse. If they just hold on, help will come. I remain confident in the fact that God knows when to cut off the hands of those going contrary to the Bible and the doctrine of the church.

I thank God for being God and for the strength He has given the Kyles Family to persevere, hold on and keep trusting God. Man failed us, but that is okay because I praise God daily for you two and others who are bold enough and saved enough to stand for righteousness. Positions, politics, and money have led so many astray until the church is not the Church of God in *Christ* anymore, but rather, the "Church of God in *Crisis*."

The General Board requested a meeting with Bishop Kyles on February 3, 2021. It is my understanding that Bishop Kurt Thompson and several others were in that meeting, also. No one was present to represent or stand alongside Bishop Kyles, as it was his understanding that the only persons scheduled to be in the meeting were him and members of the General Board. The General Board was represented by its legal counsel; but again, Bishop Kyles did not have any representatives present with him. However, regardless of who was present, Bishop Kyles felt the meeting was promising in his favor. That meeting was held six weeks ago as of tomorrow's date, March 17, 2021. At the close of the meeting, Bishop Kyles was advised that the General Board would go into an executive session and that he would be contacted at some point after that. Again, that was six weeks ago, and to date Bishop Kyles has not heard anything back from the General Board regarding the meeting.

Ironically, though, Bishop Kyles has heard from the Texas Southeast First Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction's Pastors & Elders Council – a committee handpicked by Bishop Thompson. You will recall that we sent you a copy of the letter Bishop Kyles received from Bishop Thompson's new handpicked committee advising of a new trial date. Since Bishop Thompson did not receive the results he hoped for following the first investigative hearing with Bishop Kyles and the Pastors & Elders Council, he has now sent notice of another trial against Bishop Kyles, which is scheduled for later this month. I believe a different committee is now in place to manage that particular kangaroo court. I also suspect this committee was handpicked by Bishop Thompson and has already been schooled and directed on how it should rule.

Where do these people get off??? **ENOUGH IS ENOUGH!** Something does not smell right to me. My understanding was that my husband was supposed to hear back from the General Board after the executive session; instead, he gets a letter stating there is another trial on him at the lower level. And for what??? "High and Low" seems to be the name of their game.

My questions to you two are: 1) Since you are Bishop Kyles' representatives, were you sent a copy of the letter notifying you of the trial date? You two should have been the ones to receive the notification in your capacities as Bishop Kyles' representatives, not Bishop Kyles; 2) How does Bishop Thompson, an Auxiliary Bishop, get to have all this authority? He is interim over a jurisdiction, and nothing more than that. How is it that the General Board is allowing him to get away with whatever he wants to do, knowing his actions are illegal and unconstitutional? Yes, I realize you have stated numerous times that the "real courts" will handle those wrongs. If you do not mind, though, I need answers to these questions as soon as possible. Bishop Thompson's actions feel very much like **abuse of the elderly** at this point, and that offense is a **felony in Texas**.

Somebody really wants Evangelist Temple COGIC and Texas Southeast #1 in the worst way; and it seems to me that that "somebody" is receiving help from our Church's leadership. Shame on them! All these accusations and pointing fingers while they are committing murder. I guess they feel the Ten Commandments do not apply to them. Woe be unto them because they are in for a rude awakening. Do they read their Bibles? I know they don't abide by the Word of God. The same Bible I read tells me they will be judged by it. Judgment day is coming and so is reaping what you have sown.

Bishop Kyles has gone over and beyond to follow all the mandates that were put on him, that were legitimate. It's time this "yo yo" game come to a halt. Maybe a completely new General Board will help salvage what is left of the Church of God in Christ. It is so embarrassing when someone asks what church you belong to and if you say COGIC church, they laugh at you because of all that is going on in a church they used to look up to, but that has fallen so far to the ground. I applaud how other denominations help their fallen brothers or leaders. But this "grand ole church" will help you fall, stomp you while you are


