VERDICT

This verdict form includes each of the statements on which Willie C. Green bases his claim of defamation against Moses Tyson, Jr. Answer the questions for all of the statements in accordance with the Court's instructions.

We, the jury, return the following verdicts:

As to one or more of the following statements on the internet or on the King Jives podcast, "Tyranny against the local congregation (Westside);" "shakedown;" "abusive behavior/abuse;" "shysterism;" "front man in an effort to steal property;" "trying to get the Court's assistance by using fraud;" "professional tyrant;" "perjury;" "perverting the course of justice;" "tampering with evidence;" "coercion;" "embezzlement;" "property theft;" or "organized fraud."

1(a). As to one or more of the above statements, do you find that Willie C. Green has proven all the elements of

defamation?

If you answered NO to any of the four questions above, you must find for Moses Tyson, Jr. on this claim. If you answered YES to all four questions, you should now consider the defenses raised by Moses Tyson, Jr. First, you must decide if Moses Tyson, Jr. has proven by a greater weight of the evidence that he had a qualified privilege to make the statement. If your answer is no, then you should find for Willie C. Green on the issue of qualified privilege. If your answer to the first question dealing with qualified privilege is yes, then proceed to the second question and decide whether Willie C. Green has proven by the greater weight of the evidence that Moses Tyson abused the qualified privilege. Answer yes or no as applicable.

If you find for Moses Tyson, Jr., you will not consider the matter of damages. But, if you find for Willie C. Green, you should award Willie
